For example, the new product release can provide fluid totals by eight-hour shifts, 12-hour shifts, running totals, and even totals taken from the previous day.

Another key element of the new release is the introduction of Body Mass Index (BMI) to the Growth Panel. BMI, an index of weight adjusted for stature, is a primary diagnostic tool for both obesity and protein-energy malnutrition in patients and this addition to the *iCuro* Growth Panel suite of indicators provides a more complete picture of the patient's condition than simply weight - again expanding clinicians' decision making information.

"We're very excited to release Version 4.1 as we continue to address the complex data needs of the ICU in a way that's clinician centric rather than data centric," said Dr. Chris Carnes, ICU Data Systems Vice-president and Chief Technology Officer. ICU Data Systems CEO Lori Frank added, "This newest release includes a number of important product enhancements specifically designed to increase the nurses' and physicians' ability to provide top quality patient care.
